My name is Marina Flores Sugg

I live in East Aldine, Harris County, Texas, which is in State Senate District 6 and Congressional District 29.

East Aldine is closer to the most western border of State Senate District 6 which is up by the Houston National Cemetery on Veterans' Memorial Drive.

The most eastern border of District 6 is over 50 miles away past Baytown almost to Galveston Bay.

Common sense tells you that the needs of the people living up around the western border of the district are not the same as of those people living down by the bay. We all know that all of the gerrymandering that goes on in redistricting does not really serve the needs of the people.

For this reason, I request that this honorable committee consider doing the following:
