My name is Emily Hoffman and I am from Richardson and a volunteer with All on the Line.

Richardson is a vibrant community with two colleges, two hospitals and a world class tech community. We have the Cottonwood Arts Festival and the Wildflower Music Festival every year that gather our community together. When I talk to my neighbors, the issues they are most interested in are healthcare and affordable housing. However, we vote in two school districts, two counties, have two state reps and two federal reps for a city of 116,000 population. How do we coalesce around our issues if we are segmented into so many arbitrary

political divisions? This is why I am interested in redistricting.

I ask the Texas Legislature for several things during the redistricting process.

- 1.I want a fair and non-partisan process for all citizens in Texas.
- 2.I want the methodology for re-mapping well defined and public.
- 3.I want transparency in the process. We need frequent updates, invitations to meetings, published schedules, and notification of process milestones.
- 4.I want readily available maps and map revisions.
- 5.I want all redistricting meetings open to the public.
- 6.I want all maps and redistricting processes to be legal. The state of Texas has

been in the federal courts sufficiently often that there is legal precedent that should be followed so that we don't end up in the courts again.

- 7.I want plenty of time for public feedback.
- 8.I do not want gerrymandering based on race.
- 9.In the end, what I really want is a nonpartisan redistricting board to eliminate undue influence of any political parties.


