I grew up in the farming community of Farwell in Parmer county. I now live in the oil and gas capital of Texas, Midland. I deeply value both the agricultural industry and the oil and gas industry. These two industries have been my family's livelihood forever. My dad's family is fourth generation farmers. My husband's family now all work together in a family oil business. Small family businesses like both my experiences drive the Texas and American dream.

With the past and currently proposed new redistricting, the legislature has essentially made representing these two valuable districts impossible. If valuing the constituency and being engaged with the citizens that the representatives represent is of any importance, doing more research and drawing different lines is of utmost importance. The distance and expanse of current drawings of districts would make it near impossible, with the driving time from one side to the other over 8 hours.

My recommendation would be to group Lubbock and Amarillo together, creating a district with high value of agriculture, ranching, and connection by I27. Midland, Odessa, Abilene, and San Angelo could be a district connected closely by I20 and having citizens closely engaged in the oil and gas industry.
