My name is Toby Myers. I live inside the 610 Loop in Houston, which I now hear is the most diverse city in the country, near Hermann Park and the Texas Medical Center.

Having completed the 2020 census, our country and state are in the redistricting phase. Gerrymandering is now a relevant concern. Gerrymandering because of race is illegal. Dividing districts on the basis of partisanship is not illegal. Racism and partisanship overlap and create a problem. Both Black and Hispanic communities typically favor Democratic candidates giving impetus for the oppositional manipulation. This redistricting cycle has fewer protections than those after the 2010 census. Harris County and Dallas County are going to be contentious as there are heavy minority areas in each.
