To Members of the Committee: I live in Arlington and have lived in the Arlington/Mid-Cities area for roughly 30 years. This district has been profoundly affected by the redistricting of State Senate District 10. As much as I appreciate our neighbors in largely rural counties to our west, I no longer feel that the interests of Arlington, the mid-Cities and Fort Worth -- all growing, urban/suburban areas -- are represented or appreciated.
