## Message:

In Texas state-wide races, Republican candidates generally collect about 55% of the votes. As such, the current mix of 25 Republicans and 13 Democrats (about 66% Republican) in our U.S. House delegation already over-represents Republicans here. The proposed re-districting plan, which if fulfilled would switch 5 House seats from Democrat to Republican would result in a 30-8 split (about 79% Republican) which blatantly subverts the original idea of the House being representative of the people.
