Dear Members of the Senate Special Committee  
on Congressional Redistricting,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide input on  
the congressional redistricting process.

As a resident of Fort Worth, I urge the Committee  
to prioritize fairness, transparency, and  
community representation throughout this  
process. Our district lines must reflect the  
realities of the population on the ground—  
respecting geographic boundaries, shared  
interests, and demographic continuity.

I am particularly concerned about the potential for  
gerrymandering that fragments communities of  
interest—especially those defined by race,  
ethnicity, language, or shared economic  
conditions.

To preserve the integrity of representative  
democracy in Texas, I ask the Committee to:

1. Ensure that communities of interest are  
kept whole, not split to dilute voting power.
2. Use up-to-date census and demographic  
data to reflect our region's rapid growth and  
changes.
3. Provide greater public access to draft  
maps before adoption and allow sufficient time for  
feedback.
4. Avoid drawing districts that prioritize  
political gain over public representation.

Texans deserve a map that allows all voices—rural,

urban, minority, and majority—to be fairly heard in Washington. I appreciate the Committee’s work and respectfully ask that you consider the long-term impact of this redistricting cycle on our civic health and democratic values.
