



Message:

I am writing as a concerned constituent to express my strong opposition to the ongoing mid-decade redistricting efforts being undertaken during the current special legislative session. The decision to redraw Texas's congressional maps outside of the regular decennial process undermines public trust and gives the appearance of partisan manipulation of our electoral system.
