I currently live in the 32nd congressional district, which has included sections of Dallas, Richardson, South Plano, west Garland, west Mesquite, north Balch Springs and north Carrollton - all urban areas with shared transportation and infrastructure needs, shared communities and community resources, and similar demographics. In short, this district has always represented a natural neighborhood of people in a shared community.

The current proposed redistricting would leave me in the 32nd congressional district; but make my urban area of Richardson (a diverse but tight knit community composed of a alight majority of White Americans, living in brothership with roughly equal sized groups composed of Black Americans and the majority of Dallas County's Chinese, Vietnamese, Korean, Egyptian, Libyan, Iraqi, Syrian, Jordanian, Yemeni, Moroccan, Bangladeshi and Indian immigrants) one half of a Frankenstein's monster of a district in which the other half is the city of Rowlett. Our current per-capita income is \$29k with a median income of \$73k. Richardson is a telecomm

and IT powerhouse with lots of good jobs. Rowlett is an upscale, real estate haven built around a planned resort community. Driving from Richardson to Rowlett can take an hour in rush hour traffic. We are separated by a body of water, a radically different community makeup, a different economy, a massive body of fresh water, and a 2 lane bridge that is routinely clogged with traffic. We share no infrastructure, no economy, and very little culture.

I can see only one reason you would group us together - your own corruption. Financial corruption, political corruption, and rank racism.
