Good afternoon,

I am writing about the new proposed congressional districts, which are designed to split our 38 districts to result into 30 republican seats and 8 democrat.

As of now, TX is represented by 25 republicans and 13 democrats. Republicans hold 65.8% of the available seats and democrats hold 31.7% of the available seats (there is one vacant seat).

This is already a significantly higher percentage of Republican seats compared to the statewide republican voters in the 2022 governors race (when 54% voted for Abbott) or the presidential race (when 56% voted for Trump).

Changing the districts to intentionally design 30 out of the 38 seats to be held by republicans would raise the percentage of seats held by republicans to 79%, leaving only 21% for democrats.

Considering the fact that Texas is much more evenly divided than a 79/21% (which is indisputable based on state wide election results I cited above), forcing this representation is blatantly corrupt. Please do not do this disservice to Texans who are already not adequately considered. What is being proposed is already unlawful in many states and if anything, our government should be taking steps to make elections MORE fair, not less.
