PUBLIC COMMENT – OPPOSITION TO PROPOSED
REDISTRICTING MAP

To the Members of the Texas Legislature,

This statement is submitted on behalf of the people of Texas, especially those in historically marginalized, working-class, and racially diverse communities who refuse to be divided, silenced, or ignored by political manipulation.

We strongly oppose the proposed congressional redistricting map currently under review. This plan appears to be a deliberate effort to fracture unified communities. Areas like Irving and much of the Metroplex are being carved apart in ways that serve political agendas instead of the needs of actual residents. These communities are rich in culture, voice, and civic participation, and deserve fair representation—not engineered disadvantage.

This is not a fix. It's a coordinated attempt to dismantle the collective power of voters. It reminds us of the ugliest moments in American history, when maps were drawn not to reflect the people, but to suppress them. The intent behind this redistricting is painfully clear: to secure power for a select few, while sidelining the many. We reject that premise entirely.

We believe this plan undermines the Voting Rights Act of 1965, violates the basic principle of one person, one vote, and diminishes public faith in our democratic institutions. It is a betrayal of trust and a distortion of representative government.

We demand a map that reflects the real Texas—a Texas that

is diverse, growing, and vibrant. We call for a redistricting process that centers transparency, equity, and input from the communities directly impacted.

This is our state. These are our voices. And we will not stand by while they are muted for political gain.
