Senator Creighton is in Washington, D.C. this week to advocate for federal funding for Harvey relief efforts.

WHAT: Senator Brandon Creighton (R-Conroe) is in Washington, D.C. to advocate for the 5 counties affected by Hurricane Harvey in Sen. Creighton's district. He met with top White House staff in the West Wing as well as the Army Corps of Engineers to discuss flood mitigation. Sen. Creighton also met with Texas delegation members including U.S. Senator Ted Cruz and U.S. Representative Brian Babin to discuss the massive federal budget bill passed by Congress and signed by President Trump last week. The bill includes nearly \$90 billion in disaster relief for Texas, Florida, California, the U.S. Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico.
