Senator Creighton Secures Final Passage of the Texas Education Freedom Act Largest School Choice Launch in U.S. History

AUSTIN — Today, Senator Brandon Creighton (R-Conroe) moved to concur with House amendments and secured final passage of Senate Bill 2 — the Texas Education Freedom Act — marking a transformative moment in Texas education and the largest launch of school choice in the nation's history. He offered the following statement:

"Today marks a defining moment in Texas history. With the passage of Senate Bill 2 — the Texas Education Freedom Act — we deliver on a promise more than three decades in the making. For over 30 years, lawmakers, educators, and parents have debated, dreamed, and fought for the right of families to choose the best educational path for their children. Today, we make that dream a reality.

"Passing the Texas Education Freedom Act sends a message to all of Texas. It tells the next generation of Texas leaders: your path should fit your purpose — your ambition is greater than any system. It tells our educators that innovation and excellence will be encouraged — not limited by zip code. And it tells every parent in Texas: you are trusted, you are respected, and you are in charge.

"The future of Texas begins in the classroom. Too often, we get lost in the debates about systems and budgets and programs. Not today — today, we are focused on the child at the center of it all. The one who needs a hand up, a better fit, or simply a chance."

The Texas Education Freedom Act now heads to Governor Abbott's desk for signature.
