Senator Kelly Hancock Attends North Texas Recycling Complex Grand Opening

FORT WORTH--Senator Kelly Hancock (R-North Richland Hills), today, participated in the dedication of Republic Services' North Texas Recycling Complex. Located in Fort Worth, the North Texas Recycling Complex is one of 71 recycling facilities operated by Republic Services.

Incorporated in 1998, Republic Services is one of the nation's largest waste and recycling companies and provides comprehensive waste and recycling services for more than 13 million customers across the United States and Puerto Rico. Currently, Republic Services employs more than 1,170 individuals in North Texas and, through its subsidiaries has operated in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex for more than 60 years.

"It was a pleasure to tour and participate in the dedication of the North Texas Recycling Complex. With Republic Services' operations in 39 states, the North Texas Recycling Complex is unique in that it is the most technologically advanced facility due to the use of the latest in automated monitoring, sorting, storage and baling capabilities. These capabilities allow operators to continually monitor materials through the facility, quickly process incoming materials and then ship them out as finished commodities within 24 hours of their arrival. As many as 500 tons of recyclables are moved through the North Texas Recycling Complex every day.
