## Sen. Kelly Hancock Announces District 9 Mobile Office Hours - Dec. 2017

*Senate staff available to assist area residents with state agency issues in Euless, Irving*

**North Richland Hills, TX** - Today, Texas State Senator Kelly Hancock announced the December 2017 Mobile Office Hours schedule for Senate District 9. The program is an effort to assist local residents who need help resolving an issue with a state government agency.

"More than 800,000 people live in Senate District 9," said Sen. Hancock. "We want to spread the word that our district office staff is ready and willing to help constituents cut through red tape at state agencies."

Examples of state agency casework include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Child support collection (Office of the Texas Attorney General)
- Handgun licensing (Texas Department of Public Safety)
- Insurance or utility complaints (Texas Department of Insurance / Public Utility Commission)
- State employee retirement benefits (Employee / Teacher Retirement Systems)
