STATE SENATOR LARRY TAYLOR APPOINTED TO ENERGY COUNCIL

AUSTIN - Today, Lt. Governor David Dewhurst appointed Senator Larry Taylor (Friendswood) to represent Texas on The Energy Council, a non-profit organization dedicated to promoting sound energy policy. The Council consists of 12 states: Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, Colorado, Kansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Texas, and Wyoming.

Senator Taylor recently served on The Energy Council as a member of the Texas House of Representatives from September 2011 until January 8, 2013, when he was sworn in as State Senator representing District 11. "I appreciate Governor Dewhurst's faith in me and look forward to continuing the work I did previously on the Council," said Taylor about today's appointment.

Senate District 11 is comprised of parts of Brazoria, Galveston and Harris Counties. A native Texan, Senator Taylor attended Baylor University where he received his BBA in 1982. He and his wife Kerri are the proud parents of three children. Taylor was elected to the Texas Senate in 2012 after having served 5 terms in the Texas House of Representatives.
