San Antonio Elected Officials File Bill to Clean Up Bexar County

San Antonio, Texas - Senator José Menéndez, Representative Barbra Gervin-Hawkins, and Commissioner Tommy Calvert, will file a bill to give Commissioners Court the authority to clean up residents' trash in the unincorporated area of Bexar County by requiring regular solid waste services. NE Bexar County has been plagued by derelict landlords and a non-existent infrastructure for waste service. Residents have been living in what the Express-News Editorial Board called, "[third-world conditions](#)."

Senator Menéndez, Representative Gervin-Hawkins, and Commissioner Calvert have teamed up to tackle this issue. Together, they will be announcing their legislative solution and bill to residents of the area on Friday, March 3rd at 2pm. The press conference will occur at the Army Residence Community located 7400 Crestway Dr, San Antonio, TX 78239. Neighborhood leaders and the media will have an opportunity to ask questions and engage the elected officials.
