Senator José Menéndez and the Jewish Community Relations Council Issue Statement Against Discrimination

San Antonio, Texas – This past Sunday, a white supremacist group distributed flyers in the Stone Oak and Hollywood Park neighborhood in an attempt to recruit and spread hate. The messages condoned racist attacks and hateful language.

Senator José Menéndez and the Jewish Community Relations Council released the following statement:

"The latest attempts to divide our community must be rejected. It is with great sadness that we recognize these attacks are stark reminder of our history. We must reject language and actions that attempt to divide us. As a nation, we have begun healing and our city must lead as an example. San Antonio's strength has always been in our diversity. We have more in common, than those whom attempt separate us. We ask that members of our community join us to stand against racial attacks. Together, we will remind our community that there no place for hate in San Antonio, nor in the State of Texas."
