This morning, we have filed and refiled several bills that are true to our values, have consistently been needed for every day Texans, and are common-sense solutions for the betterment of our children and State. In the following weeks, we will continue to file key pieces of legislation. We want the voices of every student, teacher, veteran, senior, the LGTBQ+ community, and all Texans to be heard.
