"Streets 2 Safety" End of Drive News Conference

El Paso - Sen. José Rodríguez, El Paso Center for Children, and Texas Veterans Commission (TVC) will have a press conference at 10 a.m. tomorrow (Friday, Oct. 12) to announce the end of the "Streets 2 Safety" donation drive for the El Paso Center for Children. Participants will announce the results of the drive and provide information on two new programs offered by the El Paso Center for Children.

The press conference will consist of the Senator, a representative from the El Paso Center for Children, a representative from the TVC, and a formerly homeless youth who now is part of the rapid rehousing program at the Center for Children. Now attending the University of Texas at El Paso, she will describe her experiences and how the center has helped her along the way.

The drive was launched in September with the goal of providing items for homeless youth and bringing awareness to the issue in our community.
