State Sen. Rodríguez and State Rep. Mary González to host Joint Town Hall

EL PASO – State Sen. José Rodríguez and State Rep. Mary E. González will host a joint Town Hall on August 15, 2019. The Town Hall will give residents an opportunity to learn about ongoing projects in the community, as well as receive updates from the 86th Legislative Session.

Senator Rodríguez currently serves as the Chairman of the Senate Democratic Caucus, and is a member of the Senate Committees on Agriculture (Vice Chair); Natural Resources & Economic Development; Transportation; and Water & Rural Affairs.
